Day 9 Suzdal

Morning walking tour of Suzdal, one of the best-preserved and prettiest towns in Russia. Visit the 11th century Kremlin, 14th century Cathedral of the Nativity and Museum of Wooden Architecture. Afternoon at leisure. Overnight Suzdal. **B**

Day 10 Suzdal to Moscow

After breakfast you will be transferred by car to Vladimir to catch your late morning train for your 4-hour journey to Moscow. Overnight Moscow. **B**

Day 11 Moscow

Tour services end after breakfast with a transfer to the airport or rail station. **B**

Day 1 St. Petersburg

Arrive St. Petersburg. You will be met and transferred to your hotel. Overnight St. Petersburg.

Day 2 St. Petersburg

Morning city tour introduces you to the major sights including the Church on Spilt Blood and Peter & Paul Fortress. You will also have a tour of the Fabergé Museum, housing a unique collection of objets d'art including nine Imperial Easter Eggs.

Day 3 St. Petersburg

Today, choose between two excursions -Peterhof on the Gulf of Finland, or the town of Pushkin, known as Tsars' Village before the Revolution. In summer months the highlight of Peterhof is its gardens with cascading fountains and golden statues. At Pushkin you will visit Catherine's Palace, one of the finest examples of Russian Baroque architecture, housing the famous 'Amber Room'. Tonight's special dinner will be at the stunning Russian Empire restaurant, housed inside the Stroganov Palace. Overnight St. Petersburg. **BLD**

Day 4 St. Petersburg to Novgorod

Morning visit to the State Hermitage Museum. Late afternoon departure for your 3-hour car transfer to Novgorod. Overnight Novgorod. **B**
