Day 1 Tue. Krakow

Arrive Krakow. You will be met and transferred to your hotel for a welcome meeting and drink. Overnight Krakow.

Day 2 Wed. Krakow

Your morning sightseeing of Krakow includes the Old Town, Wawel Castle and Wawel Cathedral. This afternoon, travel to the famous Wieliczka Salt Mine, with its lakes, grottoes and chapels carved from salt by Polish miners over 700 years. Tonight an optional dinner at a local Polish restaurant. Overnight Krakow. **B**

Day 3 Thu. Krakow to Warsaw

Morning departure for Czestochowa to visit the national shrine of the Jasna Gora Monastery and Black Madonna. Continue on through the plains, arriving Warsaw early afternoon. Overnight Warsaw. **B**

Day 4 Fri. Warsaw

Morning sightseeing tour to include the Old Town, Royal Castle, Cathedral and Barbican. Optional afternoon tour to Royal Lazienki Park and Palace. Tonight an optional dinner at a local Polish restaurant. Overnight Warsaw. **B**

Day 5 Sat. Warsaw to Mragowo

Tour north through the Masurian Lakeland to see quaint Ketrzyn, the Baroque church at Swieta Lipka and beautiful Gizycko. Late afternoon arrival and overnight Mragowo. **B**

Day 6 Sun. Mragowo to Vilnius

Travel through more Lakeland to ancient Kaunas, the former capital of Lithuania, for sightseeing. Late afternoon arrival Vilnius. Overnight Vilnius. **B**

Day 7 Mon. Vilnius

This morning you have a panoramic tour and walking tour of the Old Town with Vilnius Cathedral, Peter and Paul's Church, the Old University and Gates of Dawn. Afternoon excursion to Trakai, the medieval capital of Lithuania, and historic Trakai Castle on the island in Lake Galve. This evening take in an optional folklore show and dinner. Overnight Vilnius. **B**

Day 8 Tue. Vilnius to Riga

First a stop at the famous Hill of Crosses before reaching the magnificent Baroque Rundale Palace for a guided tour. Travel on to reach Riga late afternoon. Overnight Riga. **B**

Day 9 Wed. Riga

This morning you visit Gauja National Park with its stunning scenery and the town of Sigulda to see the Castle of Knights of the Sword. Optional afternoon tour to the Ethnographical Open Air Museum. Tonight an optional organ concert at the Dome Cathedral. Overnight Riga. **B**

Day 10 Thu. Riga

Your walking tour of the Old Town of the largest of the Baltic capitals includes Riga Castle, Dome Cathedral, St. Peters Church, the Freedom Monument and much more. This afternoon an optional excursion to the vibrant seaside resort of Jurmala and tonight an optional dinner at a stylish local restaurant. Overnight Riga. **B**

Day 11 Fri. Riga to Tallinn

Travel along the coastal highway to the seaside resort of Pärnu for a short tour, then on to Tallinn to arrive early afternoon. Overnight Tallinn. **B**

Day 12 Sat. Tallinn

Your morning sightseeing tour takes in the medieval walls, Toompea Castle, Alexander Nevsky Cathedral, the Old Town Hall and Great Guild Hall. Take an optional afternoon excursion to Kadriorg Park and KUMU. Tonight enjoy a farewell medieval dinner at Restaurant Peppersack. Overnight Tallinn. **BD**
