Your car attendants provide an attentive and friendly 24-hour housekeeping service, with an attendant always on duty, and all tours are accompanied by an on board doctor to give primary care as required, 24 hours a day. In the evenings you may relax in the Bar Lounge Car and be entertained by the resident pianist.

Imperial Suites

At 11.1m², Imperial Suites are the most spacious cabins on the Golden Eagle, with a fixed, large double bed (width 1.5 m) and lounge area with dressing table, en-suite facilities with power shower and underfloor heating, individual air-conditioning, wardrobe, safe, minibar, DVD/CD player with LCD screen and two large picture windows. Other benefits include the option of a private guide and car service, free laundry service and complimentary drinks from the Standard and Premium Bar Car List.

Gold Class

Gold Class cabins are 7m² and feature a power shower, underfloor heating, DVD/CD player with LCD screen, individual air-conditioning, wardrobe, safe, large picture window and a double lower (width 1.35m) and single upper bed. Guests in Gold Class enjoy complimentary drinks from the Standard Bar Car List.

Silver Class

Silver Class cabins are the most compact at 5.5m² and feature a small double lower (width 1.1m) bed and single upper bed, DVD/CD player with LCD screen, safe, individual air-conditioning, wardrobe and large picture window. Silver Class has its own private en-suite 'wet room' style shower and toilet.

Westbound itinerary

Day 1 Vladivostok

You will be met at Vladivostok airport and transferred to your hotel. Meet your fellow travellers at tonight's Welcome Dinner. **D**

Day 2 Vladivostok

Morning sightseeing of Russia's Far Eastern naval port, including a restored WWII submarine. After a champagne send-off complete with military band, board the Golden Eagle Trans-Siberian Express before dinner, and begin your epic rail journey. **BLD**

Day 3 Khabarovsk

Stop at Khabarovsk, just 25 km from the Chinese border, for a city tour and a visit to the Regional Museum. Reboard your train and cross the Amur River. **BLD**

Day 4 On board

Full day on board to watch the unfolding landscape as you follow the Shilka and Amur rivers. You may also wish to attend a lecture on board or Russian language lessons. **BLD**

Day 5 On board

Another full day travelling allows you to relax, improve your Russian, watch a DVD or socialise in the Bar Lounge Car. **BLD**

Day 6 Ulaanbaatar

Arrival in Mongolia, home of Genghis Khan. Your city tour of Ulaanbaatar

includes a visit to the Gandan Monastery. Then drive to Terelj National Park to visit a nomadic family in their traditional ger. As an alternative, you may choose to remain in Ulaanbaatar to explore further. Board your train in time for dinner. **BLD**

Day 7 Ulan Ude

Afternoon arrival in Ulan Ude, capital of the Buryat Republic. The ethnic and cultural diversity of the region offers a unique insight into its heritage. Explore the Old Believers' Village, learn about its culture and history and enjoy a traditional concert. **BLD**

Day 8 Lake Baikal

For five hours, the train is hauled by a Soviet-era steam locomotive, winding its way through tunnels along cliff-hugging tracks above Lake Baikal, the world's oldest and deepest freshwater lake. Continue with a boat trip to Listvyanka, a small Baikal settlement nestling at the base of the surrounding hills. Weather permitting; enjoy a delicious barbecue, including freshly smoked omul fish, on the shore of Lake Baikal to complete a memorable day. **BLD**

Day 9 Irkutsk

Explore Irkutsk's most significant sites and museums. See the distinctive wooden lace architecture and visit the Volkonsky House Museum, dedicated to exiled aristocrats.

Enjoy a private concert before boarding the waiting train for dinner. **BLD**

Day 10 On board

A day to relax, unwind and enjoy the ever-changing landscape passing your window as the train makes its way to Novosibirsk. **BLD**

Day 11 Novosibirsk

Novosibirsk is a modern "Soviet" city. Your city tour includes the Opera House, the largest in the world, housing two permanent opera and ballet companies, or you may visit the Railway Museum as a Freedom of Choice option. **BLD**

Day 12 Yekaterinburg

Founded in 1723 by Peter the Great, Yekaterinburg is the capital of the Urals and the fourth-largest city in Russia. Your city tour includes the poignant site where the last tsar Nicholas II and his family were executed by the Bolsheviks in 1918. The train crosses the Europe/Asia divide after leaving Yekaterinburg. **BLD**

Day 13 Kazan

Mid-morning arrival in Kazan, the capital of the Tatarstan Republic, situated on the Volga River. One of the highlights of today's city tour is the Kremlin, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Within the walls of this ancient citadel is a stunning mosque and magnificent onion-domed cathedral. **BLD**

Day 14 Moscow

Arrive Moscow, your final destination on this epic 11,000 km journey. Your city tour includes the Kremlin and Armoury Museum or you may choose from Freedom of Choice options such as the Tretyakov Art Gallery or Space Museum. Transfer to the 5-star Ritz Carlton Hotel and say goodbye to your fellow travellers at tonight's Farewell Dinner. **BLD**

Day 15 Moscow

Your tour services end today with a transfer to the airport. Or you may choose to extend your stay in Moscow or continue to St. Petersburg. **B**
